

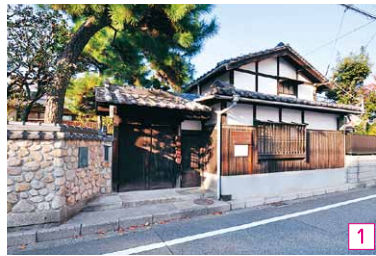
ASHIYA CITY GUIDE MAP

1. The Former Residence of Saika Tomita 3-B

The poet Saika Tomita, considered the "father of culture in Hyogo Prefecture" settled in Ashiya in 1920. His acclaimed book "*Uta-Fudo-ki*, Hyogoken" was issued after the War. In the former residence of Saika Tomita, Junichiro Tanizaki once stayed, you can appreciate valuable relics and manuscripts, letters, documents and other materials exhibited with the help of the "Saika Tomita Honors Committee"

2. Junichiro Tanizaki Memorial Museum of Literature 2-C

Opened in 1988 as a memorial museum for a great writer Junichiro Tanizaki. The museum exhibits manuscripts, letters and daily items donated by his wife, Matsuko Tanizaki and other collectors. You will know the life and work of Junichiro Tanizaki through them.

3. Ashiya City Museum of Art and History 2-C

The museum is formed from Art section and History section. You can see the work of artists familiar with Ashiya such as Jiro Yoshihara and Narashige Koide.

In the yard of the museum, the atelier of Narashige Koide is restored and in the atelier, his art materials and manuscripts of his books.

4. Kyoshi Memorial Museum 1-C

The museum was established in 2000 as memorial museum for Kyoshi Takahama, a great poet. The museum is divided into five themes in the footsteps of Kyoshi.

Exhibitions include correspondence between Shiki Masaoka and Kyoshi and also a manuscript of one of Japan's best known novels, "I Am a CAT", by Natsume Soseki.

5. Ashiyagawa River 2-A,B,C

Ashiyagawa River has a total length of approx. 6km from its source in the Rokko Mountains.

This river provides citizens with an excellent spot to relax and walk. In spring, cherry blossoms bloom and one of the three major festivals in Ashiya, the "Cherry Blossom Festival" takes place along the banks.

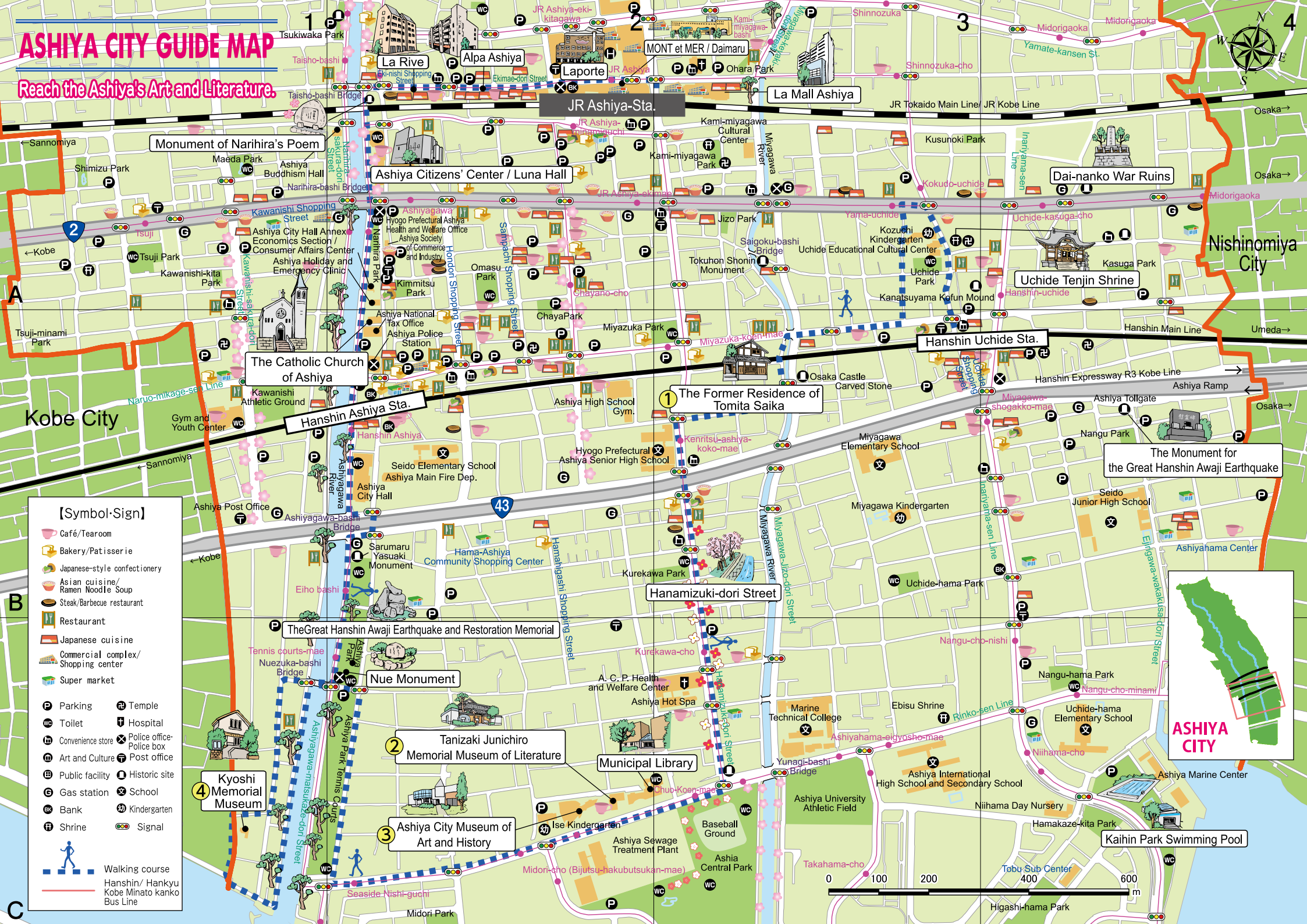

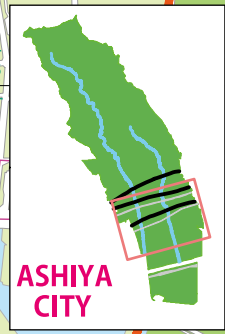
