Join Hyogo Mutual Aid Program for Housing Reconstruction

Based on the lessons learned from past earthquakes, Hyogo Prefecture has established the Hyogo Mutual Aid Program for Housing Reconstruction to complement self-help efforts and public assistance for dealing with the destruction inflicted by natural disasters. For a small annual premium, homeowners in Hyogo can enroll in the program to receive a variety of benefits for housing reconstruction, purchases, repairs, and more if their home is seriously damaged or destroyed by an earthquake or other natural disaster. The premium and benefits are listed below.

As this mutual aid program differs from insurance, those who already hold earthquake insurance or other such policies are also eligible to enroll in the program. The city government urges residents to join, as this small investment can provide enormous peace of mind.

Premium: ¥5,000/year (¥500/month

for first year)

Benefits: (1) ¥6,000,000 for home reconstruction or purchases following partial or full destruction (*hankai* or higher damage rating) by natural disaster.

(2) ¥2,000,000 for home repairs if *zenkai* rating, ¥1,000,000 if *daikibo-hankai*, ¥500,000 if *hankai*.

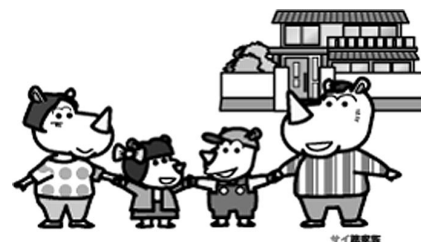
(3) ¥100,000 for other needs in securing housing

To enroll: Fill out an enrollment form and mail it to the office listed on the form. Forms are available at the following locations:

(1) Hyogo Prefectural Office, prefectural branch offices, city offices

(2) Post offices, financial institutions (SMBC, Bank of Mitsubishi-Tokyo UFJ, Tajima Bank, Minato Bank, Ikeda Bank, credit associations, workers' credit unions, etc.)

(3) Certain hospitals, clinics, and dentist offices



(4) Large retail outlets (Co-op Kobe, Sogo, Daimaru, Yamatoyashiki, Saty, MaxValu, Kansai Supermarket, Kohnan, etc.)

(5) Train terminals (Kobe Electric Railway, Kobe Rapid Railway, Sanyo Electric Railway, Shinki Bus, etc.)

Evacuation Sites Designated for Minami-ashiyahama

According to the Hyogo Society for Tsunami Research, a magnitude 8.4 Nankai Earthquake in the ocean south of the Kii Peninsula and Shikoku could generate a 3-meter tsunami along the Hanshin coast. Since the seawalls in the Ashiyahama and Minami-ashiyahama districts are five meters tall, the risk of flooding from such a tsunami is considered very low, but the city government has taken the extra safeguard of designating the following locations as temporary evacuation sites, effective as of Dec. 20, 2005.

Tsunami evacuation sites:

Corridors on 3rd or higher floors of prefecturally/municipally operated high-rise apartment buildings in Minami Ashiyahama

Disaster evacuation sites:

Assembly halls of prefectural-

ly/municipally operated high-rise apartment buildings in Minami Ashiyahama

Heard about garbage 'yellow cards'?

Under the slogan of "An eco-friendly Ashiya built by residents," the city government is committed to making the most of the earth's limited resources and reshaping Ashiya into a recycling-based community. One of the strategies for achieving this goal is to separate different types of garbage.

Although most residents willingly cooperate with this policy, there still are some who cause a great nuisance to their neighbors by putting out the wrong type of garbage on the wrong day.

In order to remedy this situation, municipal sanitation workers stick "yellow card" notices on improper waste and leave it at the collection site.

If you are ever issued one of these notices, please take your garbage back home and dispose of it on the correct day.

Light Vehicle Taxes

Every year a light vehicle tax is assessed on people who own a light vehicle (including moterbikes) as of April 1. If you no longer possess a vehicle due to disposal, title transfer or theft, you must update the registration to avoid being taxed. If you move out of Ashiya, you need to withdraw your registration in Ashiya and then register the vehicle in your new location. You must also report disposal if you plan to leave Japan. Please bring the required documentation to the office below to complete the applicable procedures.

Please note that even if you file the disposal record in the middle of the year, you will still be responsible for paying the entire tax, as there is no refund for the remainder of the year.
